## Course Overview and Objectives

This course is designed to provide a provocative update to physicians with a multidisciplinary team approach in order to address the continuum of care for patients. Attendees will gain knowledge about their own specialty as well as increased knowledge and application of other specialties. Interactive presentations will emphasize current applications of these techniques which will complement the challenges of daily clinical practice. Participants will be encouraged to discuss technical and operational issues with the faculty and presenters.

As a result of participation in this program, attendees will better be able to: evaluate and apply appropriate techniques to the assessment of heart disease and heart failure; determine appropriate diagnostic techniques; and assess what is the best treatment for high-risk patients.
